


The rational

FameLab aims

 Identify and support new science communicators

 Encourage scientists, technologists, engineers and mathematicians to find their voices and inspire and excite the public imagination

FameLab takes place in:

- Science Centres
 - Museums
 - Theatres
 - Galleries
 - Industry venues
 - Universities

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Who are the judges?

- 3 or 4 Judges
 - -Scientists and communicators, actors, showman
 - Immediately after the presentation ask questions to the contestant

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


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A content

- Choose something that is relevant to you and make it relevant for others

A story

- Clearly define the beginning and the end
- Decide if it's a real story or a fiction
- Choose the appropriate language to tell the story (be yourself)
- Test the story with some friends of yours




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Objects?

- An object might inspire you while thinking to the story
- The story might need a visual hook represented by an object
- Simple objects work better
- Practise as much as possible the use of the object

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Body and voice

- Your movement are the punctuation of your speach
- Your voice stresses the main points of your talk
- Your body can be an instrument
